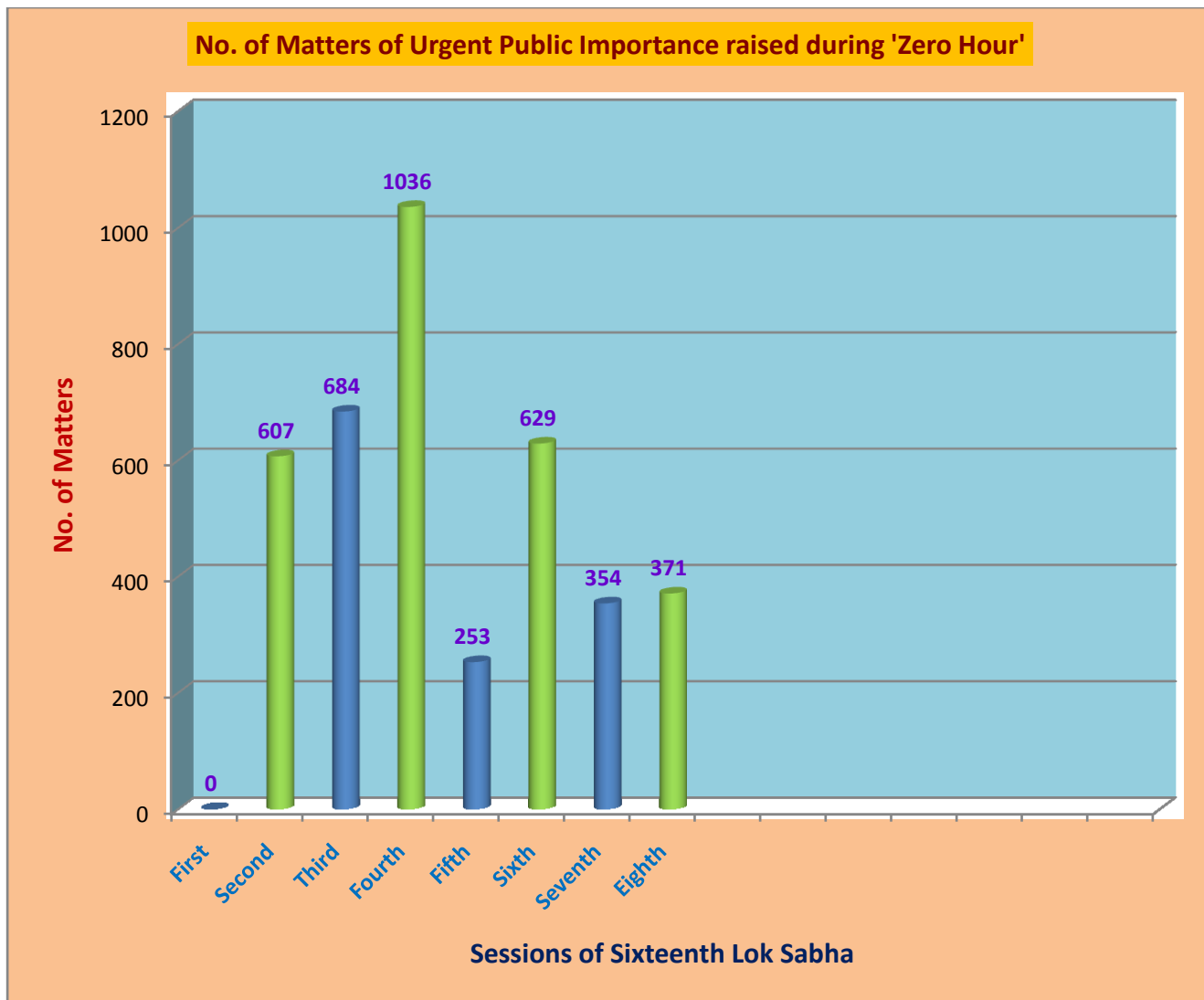
8. No. of matters raised under Rule 377 (Eighth Session) 236

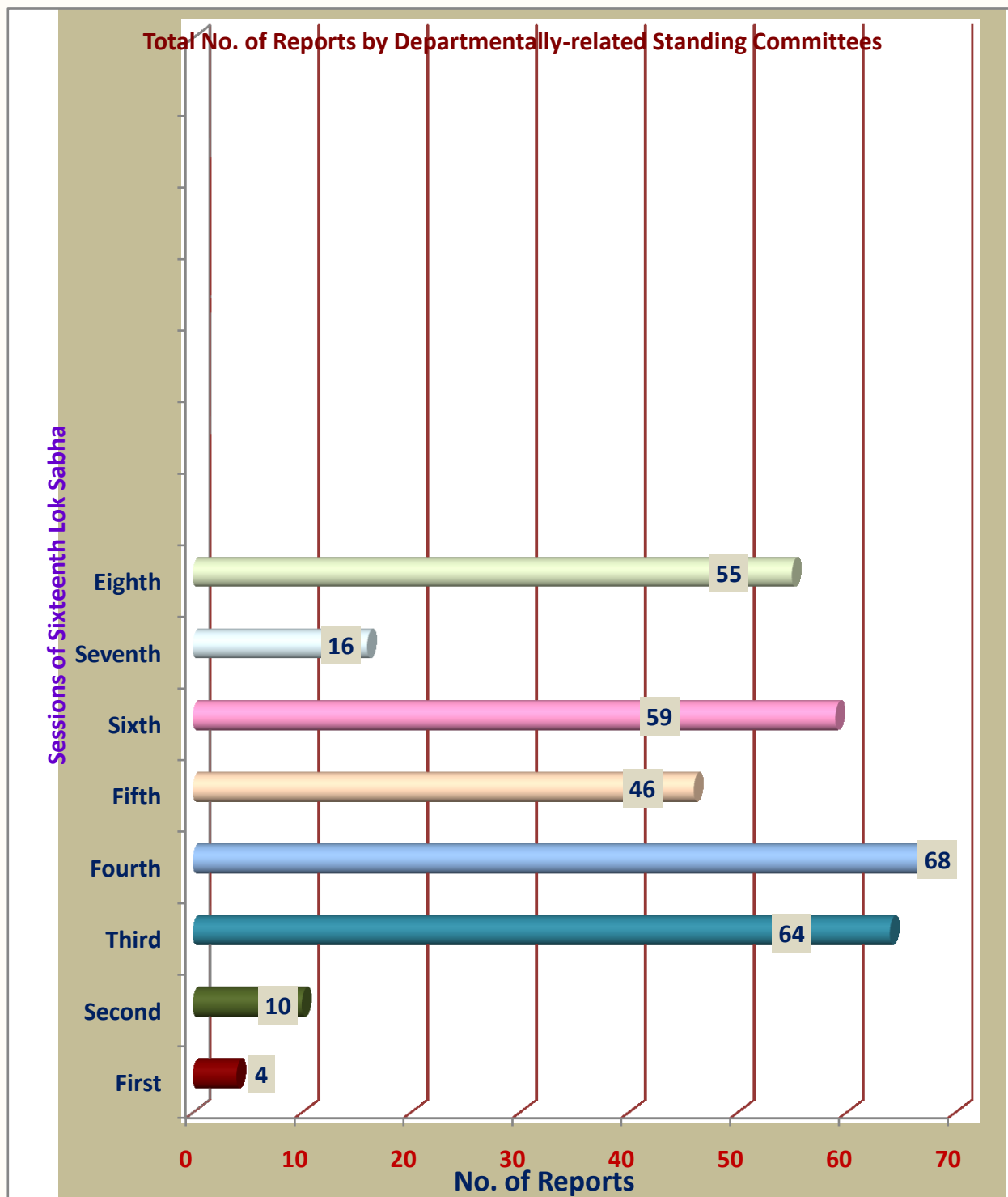

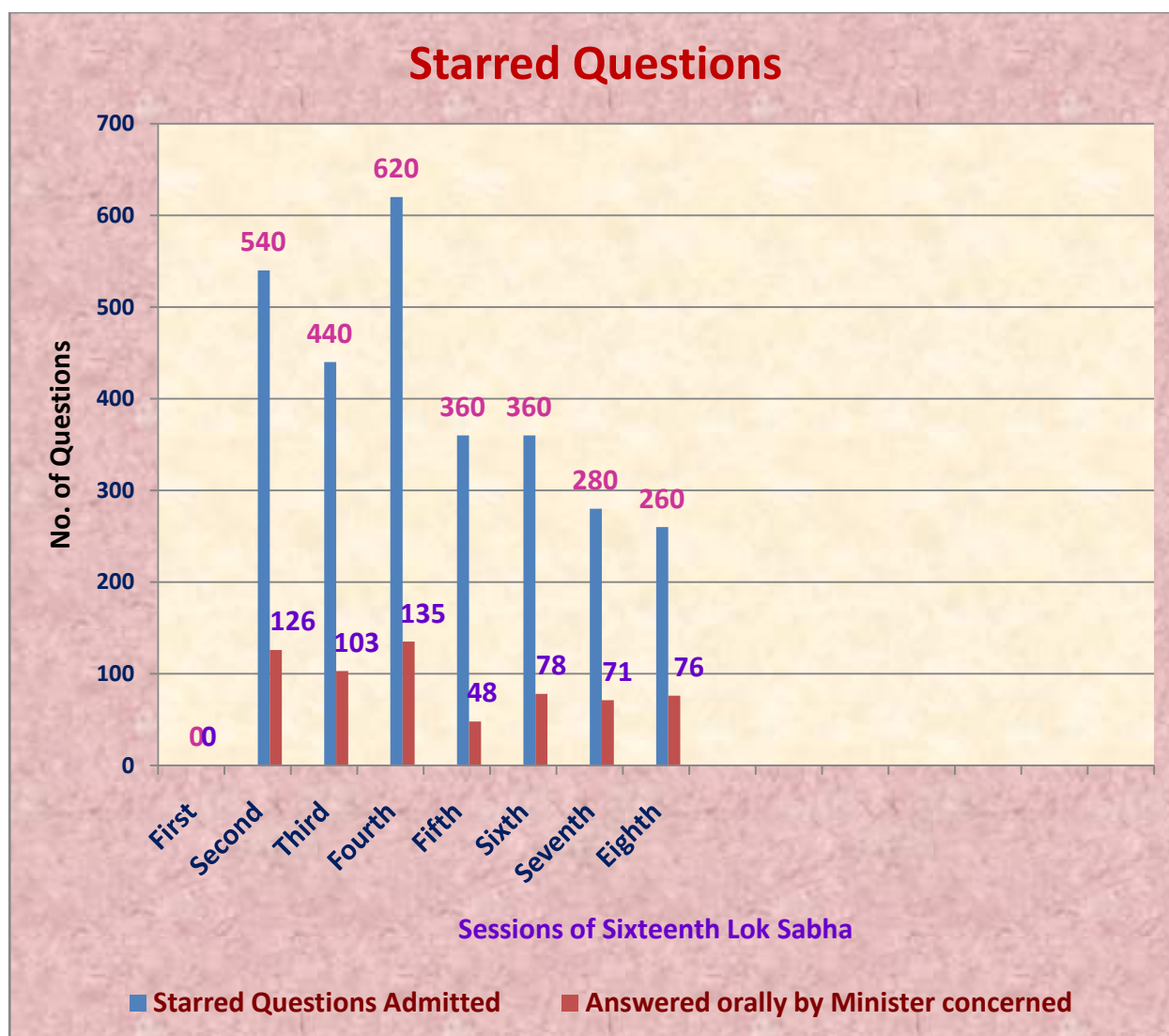

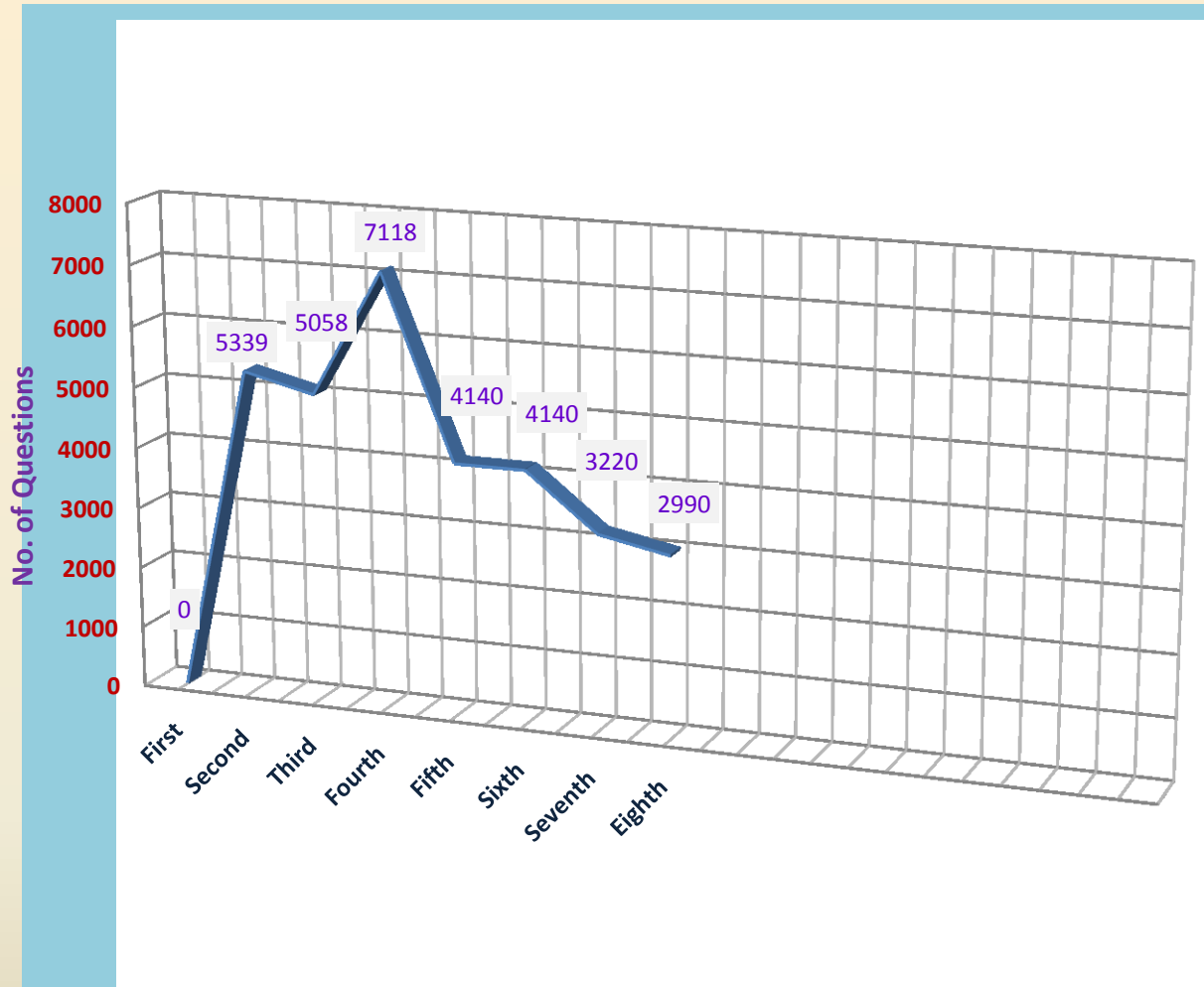
